

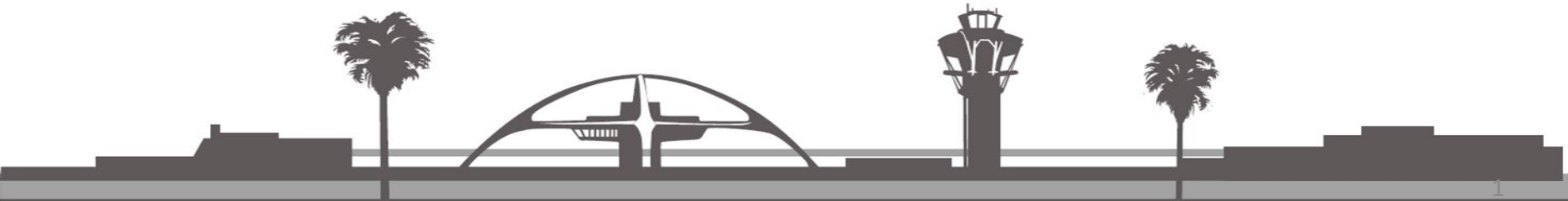

# What is the LAX Fly Quieter Program?

---

A Recognition Program designed to:

- Encourage and acknowledge airlines for operating as quietly as possible
- Increase airline/pilot awareness of and compliance with LAX Aircraft Noise Abatement Operating Procedures and Restrictions
- Score/grade and rank all operators on their performance and acknowledge those operators that make the greatest efforts to reduce noise

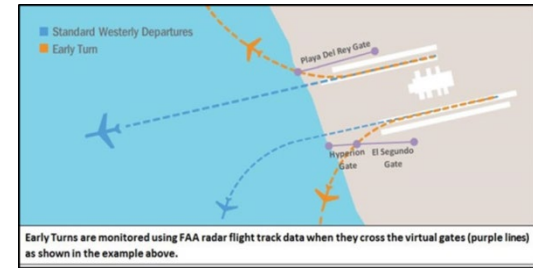
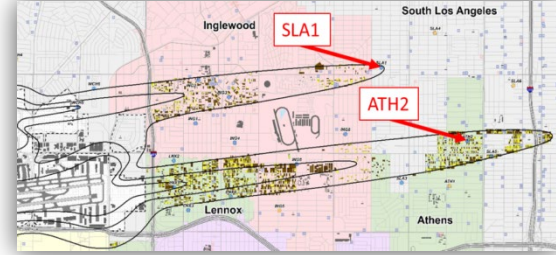
# What is the LAX Fly Quieter Program?

---

- **Similar to other fly quiet programs** at airports such as LHR, OAK, ORD, SAN, SEA and SFO in that it evaluates, scores and ranks operators on their performance in reducing noise to surrounding communities.
  - **LAWA surveyed airports** with fly quiet programs to obtain feedback regarding the success of their program, what they might have done differently and criteria and elements used to evaluate operators.
- ... we're in the process of developing these criteria and elements.

# Possible LAX FQP Criteria/Elements

- **Measured Noise Levels**
  - Quietest Arrivals, Quietest Fleet
- **Community Overflights and Flight Procedures**
  - For example: Early Turns, East Departures, North Downwind Arrival Altitude, Extended North Downwind Arrivals, Palos Verdes Peninsula Overflights, Maintenance Engine Run-up Curfew



# Possible LAX FQP Criteria/Elements

---

- **Operator Noise Reduction and Engagement Efforts**
  - Opportunity for operators to obtain bonus points to improve their score and rank
    - Voluntary efforts to further demonstrate their commitment to reducing noise and engaging with the community
    - For example: pilot education, aircraft retrofit (vortex generator) and participation in Roundtable meetings

**Bonus Criteria will set LAX Fly Quieter Program apart from other airport fly quiet programs**

# LAX Fly Quieter Program Reporting

---

- **Quarterly**
  - Quarterly status reports to Operators to monitor and track their score
  - Opportunity for Operators to make changes/initiate effort to improve their annual score
- **Annual**
  - Annual report to Operators providing final score
  - Publicly announce winners

# LAX FQP Awards and Recognition

---

- **LAWA will develop a FQP Awards and Recognition Plan to include types of formal publicity, such as:**
  - Awards Announcement (e.g., BOAC presentation, awards luncheon, etc.)
  - Public Recognition (e.g., banners, billboards, advertisement in print media, social media, etc.)
- **Awards and Recognition Plan will be implemented for 2020 LAX Fly Quieter Program winners**

<b>Implement LAX Fly Quieter Program Awards and Public Recognition</b>	Q1 2021
