

TBIT FUEL SYSTEM SHUTDOWN

PLH Aviation Services will be shutting down the Tom Bradley International Terminal (TBIT) fuel system to perform annual system pressurization tests in February, 2013. There will be three separate shutdowns: one for the north side, second shutdown for the south side, third shutdown for the west (remote) gates, and finally the Bradley West Gates.

Here are the details:

- First Shutdown: TBIT North side, February 19th, 2013, starting at 0001L until 0800L.
- Second Shutdown: TBIT South side, February 20st, 2013, starting at 0001L until 0800L.
- Third Shutdown: West gates, February 21st, 2013, starting at 0001L until 0800L.
- Fourth Shutdown: Bradley West Gates, February 22nd, 2013, starting at 0001L until 0800L.

There will be no hydrant fueling available at TBIT during these hours. ARCC Gate Control will make every effort to coordinate gate assignments that will help to minimize the impact of these shutdowns.

PLH Aviation Services has been advised to check with the ARCC prior to each shutdown to confirm all departure activity is complete for that evening.
