

PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE 6 DEMOLITION PROJECT – ROADWAY IMPACT

- **INTERMITTENT LANE RESTRICTIONS ON BOTH LEVELS FROM APRIL 22ND TO MAY 23RD**
- **FULL CLOSURE OF DEPARTURE LEVEL AND PARTIAL CLOSURE OF ARRIVAL LEVEL ON MAY 16TH AND 17TH FROM 2AM TO 3:30AM**

The work to remove Pedestrian Bridge 6 is underway with soft demolition taking place nightly from approximately 10PM to 7AM through May 23rd. A portion of lanes on both the departure and arrival levels at Terminal 6 may be restricted. On select nights, Ride App Pick-up “E” (Uber/Lyft stop) and waiting areas for the Flyaway/Charter, LAX Shuttle, and Hotel/Private Parking Shuttle services will be closed at Terminal 6. Patrons for these services will be redirected to the nearest waiting areas. Sidewalk will remain open at all time. Most of the roadway will be fully restored after 7AM each day.

The removal of the bridge frames will take place on the evenings of May 16th and 17th from 2AM to 3:30AM. Full closure of the departure level will be required during this time. Measures may be made for vehicles stuck on the departure level during the full closure to exit to the arrival level. While this contingency is in place it will be exercised on a limited basis. There will also be partial closure of the arrival level but traffic lanes will be maintained. Concession and construction deliveries will not be allowed during these two nights. The latter nights of this project will be spent demobilizing heavy equipment and clean-up. The project is expected to be completed by May 23rd.
