Thank you for your interest in the Los Angeles World Airports GATEWAYS College Internship Program. Please complete the Student Internship Request Form (SIRF) and attach your résumé. Once completed, please send all documents to Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA), Community Relations Division , 6053 Century Blvd., Suite #301 (3rd floor), Los Angeles, CA 90045.

Kindly note, that submission of the SIRF does not guarantee your acceptance into the internship program, it places you on a waiting list. Upon receipt of the SIRF and your résumé, the Community Relations will forward your information to the 2 divisions indicated on your SIRF. Please be sure to specify which airport location (LAX, VNY) you wish to work for along with the division.

Please note that all interns are required to work a minimum of two days and 10 hours per week. If you are accepted into the GATEWAYS Internship Program, the placement process with LAWA takes approximately four to six weeks. Your résumé will remain on file for one year.

Gateways Student Professional Worker (SPW)/ Paid Program

The Gateways College Internship Program is a one-year program. Students can work up to 1040 hours or one-year, whichever comes first; SW's and SPWs are also required to maintain a minimum GPA of a 2.7 and be enrolled in a college or university as fulltime student. *International students are encouraged to apply.

Gateways Student Volunteer/Non-Paid Program

If applying for the Volunteer Program, volunteers are asked to make a four month commitment to the program. *International students are encouraged to apply.
