USCIS Temporary Protected Status (TPS) Latin American & Caribbean Designated Countries

Haiti

TPS To Terminate On:	July 22, 2019 / Must have EAD Card
Re-registration Period for People Who Already Have TPS:	Jan. 18, 2018 – March 19, 2018
Employment Authorization Document (EAD) Auto-Extended Through:	July 21, 2018

El Salvador

TPS To Terminate On:	Sept. 9, 2019
Re-registration period for People Who Already Have TPS:	Jan. 18, 2018 – March 19, 2018
Employment Authorization Document (EAD) Auto-Extended Through:	Sept. 5, 2018

Honduras

TPS To Terminate On:	Jan. 5, 2020
Re-registration period for People Who Already Have TPS:	June 5, 2018 through Aug. 6, 2018
Employment Authorization Document (EAD) Auto-Extended Through:	Jan. 1, 2019

Nicaragua

TPS To Terminate On:	Jan. 5, 2019
Re-registration Period for People Who Already Have TPS:	Dec. 15, 2017, through Feb. 13, 2018
Employment Authorization Document (EAD) Auto-Extended Through:	March 6, 2018 Additionally, the EADs of TPS beneficiaries who timely re-register (Form I-821, Application for Temporary Protected Status) and file a request for a new EAD (Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization) will be automatically extended through July 4, 2018.

Note: All applicants who fall under one of these categories (affected countries) must present the following when they come to the Badge Office for processing: (Originals and Copies of all documents must be presented)

1. Employment Authorization Document (EAD)
2. Receipt indicating re-registration date
3. All required Fingerprinting/Badge-related applications

Note: Applicants who have applied during the re-registration period and who have not received the new EAD are eligible for the 180-day extension and will be processed with a short-date badge, not to exceed the EAD Auto Extension for that country (see above).

Note: Applicants who have NOT re-registered may receive a short-date badge not to exceed the re-registration **period** date for that country (see above).
