Expectations of the LAXceeders: provide guests with an LAXceptional Experience, while displaying a professional attitude and appearance while on duty; meet and greet guests while standing in key locations allowing guests to easily approach you for directions or assistance; assist with internal events at LAX.

Minimum Requirements: volunteer a minimum of two (2) hours during the week or three (3) hours on the weekend, each week; participate in training programs and meetings relevant to the LAXceeders Student Volunteer Program; be at least 16 to 24 years of age and currently enrolled in high school or an undergraduate college program.

Ability to: Communicate effectively to a diverse public; interact effectively with airport employees and guests; strictly adhere to security regulations and abide by policies of the Los Angeles World Airports; provide a valid photo ID (student ID or driver's license); complete and pass Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) fingerprint and badging process; provide own transportation to/from airport;

Eligible candidates will be scheduled to attend an interview session. After successfully completing the interview, LAXceeders will complete a training program that includes guest services techniques, latest procedures in airport security and airline check-in procedures, airport services and amenities, travel and hospitality resources, and Internet and computer training.
